Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$3,000,000 in funding for the Bay Area Community Health - Irvington Clinic Renovation project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Bay Area Community Health, located at 40910 Fremont Blvd. Fremont, CA 94538.

This funding will be used for renovating the second floor of Bay Area Community Health's Irvington Clinic in Fremont to medical and behavioral health services, including mental health counseling. The project will convert underutilized space into counseling rooms, psychiatric treatment areas, and integrated care spaces for mental health services. This project is an appropriate usage of taxpayer funds because it will increase access to timely, culturally responsive behavioral health care for low-income and vulnerable populations, while strengthening the community healthcare safety net and improve mental health outcomes in Alameda County.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act.
