Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$2,200,000 in funding for the Santa Clara Vision Zero Safety Corridor Improvements Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Santa Clara, located at 1500 Warburton Avenue, Santa Clara, CA 95050.

This funding will be used to implement engineering safety countermeasures along the City of Santa Clara's identified High-Injury Network (HIN) in the Vision Zero Action Plan. The HIN identifies the roadways and intersections that experienced highest number of fatal and severe injury collisions. By focusing on these high-risk corridors and intersections, Santa Clara can make the biggest impact in reducing severe injuries and fatalities. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project will design and construct Vision Zero traffic safety improvements such as signal modifications, curb extensions, intersection treatments, ADA curb ramps, and accessible pedestrian signals at the High-Injury Network roadways and intersections identified in the Santa Clara Vision Zero Action Plan.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2) and 5305(a)(5).
