SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

1	SEC. 2. CONCENTRATED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATION DIS-
2	CHARGES.
3	Section 402 of the Federal Water Pollution Control
4	Act (33 U.S.C. 1342) is amended by adding at the end
5	the following:
6	"(t) Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation
7	DISCHARGES.—
8	"(1) IN GENERAL.—For the purposes of apply-
9	ing the requirements of this section to a discharge
10	from a concentrated animal feeding operation, the
11	Administrator shall require all persons exercising
12	substantial operational control over the concentrated
13	animal feeding operation to jointly obtain a permit
14	under this section for the discharge.

16	For purposes of this subsection, a person exercises

19	"(A) has an ownership interest in the live-

23	ties, operation (including specifying how the

25	eration is fed, grown, or medicated), or man-

3	"(C) meets any other criteria that the Ad-
4	ministrator determines appropriate.".
