I am requesting \$1,900,000 in funding for the Warehouse Renovations and Improvements project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is Sunnyvale Community Services, located at 725 Kifer Road, Sunnyvale, CA 94086.

The funding would be used for installing a solar energy system with storage to improve energy efficiency of the facility. The energy savings will lower occupancy costs and allow the non-profit to use more funds for food and other critical needs. This is particularly important because of the high electricity costs of operating the nonprofit's cooler and freezer, where they handle and distribute up to two million pounds of food annually each year, including USDA provided food. The funding will also be used for improvements to community rooms and installing a polished concrete coating to the existing untreated, and cracking, concrete warehouse floor. This will ensure a safer and more durable floor surface throughout the warehouse to safely work in any area of the warehouse, regardless of age and mobility. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it supports community development consistent with federally authorized programs.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
