I am requesting \$2,725,000 in funding for the De La Cruz Blvd, Lick Mill Blvd, and Scott Blvd Bicycle Projects in fiscal year 2022. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Santa Clara located at 1500 Warburton Avenue Santa Clara, CA 95050.

The funding would be used to complete traffic analyses, public outreach, design, and construction of bicycle facilities on three corridors in Santa Clara, CA 95054 (De La Cruz Blvd: Montague Expressway to Trimble Road, Lick Mill Blvd: Tasman Drive-Montague Expressway, and Scott Blvd: Calabazas Creek Trail to Saratoga Avenue).

The project will enhance safety, improve mobility, and reduce vehicle emissions by implementing high priority bicycle projects identified in the Santa Clara Bicycle Plan Update 2018. The project will connect local residential communities, schools, libraries, and major employers within Silicon Valley.
