I am requesting \$292,685 in funding for a Student Wellness Center in fiscal year 2022. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Santa Clara County Office of Education located at 1290 Ridder Park Dr. San Jose, CA 95131.

The funding would be used to open a wellness center at Milpitas High School, located at 1285 Escuela Pkwy Milpitas, CA 95035. The wellness center will provide students critical, time sensitive prevention and early intervention services to address student mental health and trauma. This funding will be bolstered through seed funding to open nine wellness centers through a California Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission grant.

This funding will meet a critical, urgent student need during the COVID-19 recovery phase. The federally funded wellness center will provide immediate access to services through an accessible universal wellness center at a high school within CA-17.
